National Title Fuel sample direct to Deacon University and answers back to National Secretary only no cc's. We require addresses for the members doing national titles after the allocations from the Board to get fuel sample kits sent to states

Mr Montague re exhausts flanges on Junior Sedans – Flange must be standard and other pipes must be as per Specification Book – Norm will answer

This will also give us the opportunity to make sure every state has the same understanding of each rule. We will also have time to talk about concerns the Stewards have about the rule book.

I held the first training course using the new rule book. This was held in Newman, one of the states North West clubs. There was positive feedback with all in attendance seeing the advantages of all divisions using the same rule book.

It is now time for all the states to start organizing training for all their officials and driver's before the next speedway season commences.
