CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ALL PARTICIPATING COMPETITORS**



AT ALL TIMES

Any form of social media, twitter, text, Facebook etc; derogatory comments, abuse or threats will not be tolerated penalties will apply as per the Social Media Policy – refer to SSA Media Policy in Racing Rule Book

BEHAVIOUR AT RACE MEETING:

- Always comply with the rules
- Competitors are responsible for their own conduct as well as the conduct of any person associated with them, such as, Pit Crews, Vehicle Owners and Sponsors
- Most Stewards have volunteered their services for the smooth, efficient and fair conduct of the race meeting
- Avoid arguing with a Steward – if you disagree with a ruling, quietly check with the Official on how the decision was reached
- Control your temper – verbal and physical abuse of stewards or other competitors and deliberately distracting or provoking others is not acceptable or permissible behaviours
- Treat all competitors as you would like to be treated – do not interfere with, bully or take advantage of any other participant
- Avoid the use of coarse or derogatory language

PREPARING TO RACE

- Driver is responsible for car owner and crew at all times at race meeting
- Driver and crew must be dressed in appropriate clothing and foot wear
- No smoking in Pit Area and track arena unless in designated area

SCRUTINEERING

- Track scrutineering will be conducted at the allocated area and within the allocated time period

WORKING ON CARS

- Driver and crew working on race cars in a safe manner and using safe methods at all times – eg jack stands, approved fuel containers etc

RACE TIME

- Bring race car to dummy grid when called at a safe pace
- Driver to be ready to race with seat belts tight and helmet and other safety equipment secured

AFTER RACE HAS FINISHED

- Driver to leave race track at a safe speed and must not break traction when driving in the Pit Area

No registration will be issued without payment being completed. **PLEASE ALLOW TIME FOR THE PROCESSING AND RETURN OF YOUR REQUIREMENTS up to 14 days.**
5. The only recognized Licence to drive a Nostalgia Sedan or a Super Street Sedan is a Speedway Australia competition licence – obtained directly from www.speedwayaustralia.org
6. Applications to register cars must be accompanied by the current Daylight Inspection completed not more than 90 days previously.
7. Daylight Inspection to be completed by a currently registered SSA Scrutineer.
8. Daylight Inspection sheets must be in the same name as the intended registered car owner.
