Each driver has 3 heats All heats will be maximum 10 laps Maximum of 12 cars per Heat Points - 36,28,23,17,13,10,8,6,5,4,3,2 and 1 to all other finishers NO RESERVE CARS for any Heat or Main event All drivers must compete in the allocated Heat or Main event

A MAIN 1 x A Main event will be run over 40 laps – maximum 24 cars
 Top 16 qualifiers plus sufficient cars in finishing order from each of the B Mains to equal maximum of 24 starters. This number includes the Defending Champion as per *Rule No* 4.30.3 - *The previous year's* champion shall be allowed to defend title but must compete in heats. However, if the champion fails to qualify in this manner a rear of the field start is permitted in their own or a substitute car.
